## **General Rules and Regulations**

- 1) Only those students who studied under west Bengal Council of H.S. Education / C.B.S.E / I.S.C / National Institute of Open Schooling / RabindraMuktaVidyalaya and other recognized Boards which are approved by the University of Calcutta are eligible to fill in the application form directly from the college website.
- 2) Admission taken on the basis of false statement or misstatement, found at any point of time shall be summarily cancelled and there will be no money refund.
- 3) Dates and Time of admission must be strictly followed. No extension of date and time will be specially granted to anyone.
- 4) Candidates applying for one subject may also apply separately for another subject by following the same procedure mentioned above, he or she has to pay only **Rs.300/-** for all applications.
- 5) **Candidates can apply for all eligible courses by paying onetime payment of Application Fee Rs. 300/- through On-Line Payment System or Off-line Payment (Challan) System.**
- 6) **Class Hour : 10:15 a.m. to 5:15 p.m.**
- 6) Application Forms will not be considered valid unless payment (On-line/Off-line) is made to the Bank.

## **Admission Qualifications**

1. A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10 + 2) or its equivalent examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3-year (Six Semester) B.A/ B.Sc./ B.Com (Honours & General) Course of Studies under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100. However, no candidate shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination of recognized regular course of study. Year of Passing must not be before **2014**. **But the students passed before 2019 should not register in old (1+1+1 Regulation) system of the University of Calcutta or anywhere and appeared CU final examinations under (1+1+1) system.**

**Explanation:** *The year of Admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. Contact College Office for more information.*

2. If adequate number of Scheduled Tribe candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Caste candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste Candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Tribe candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates is not available, even after that, the seats may be made available to General Category candidates provided approval is available from the appropriate Government Department.

5. School Leaving Certificate/Character Certificate (Only Original)
6. Students who have passed before 2018 must reproduce transfer certificate and break of study certificate from the local Councilor or Panchayat Pradhan at the time of admission.
7. Two (2) copies of stamp sized colour photo.
8. Duly paid Applicant's Copy and College copy of Bank Challan.
